There's a £100 up for grabs if either the men's or ladies' records are beaten. Plus there's £25 for any runner who breaks any of the vet category course records. We will be once again staging a 1-mile fun run within the grounds of the school, which is completely traffic free. There are plenty of prizes on offer for the various age categories. If you enter your kids online beforehand, you'll save yourself £1.50, as it will be a £5 if you enter on the day.



Bag store: Baggage can be left in the Jubilee Hall, which is the main Race HQ.

Toilets, changing & showers: There are plenty of toilets throughout the building, as well as separate male and female changing/shower rooms. These will be clearly signed.

Food (cash please): The Trotters are renowned for their amazing cakes, of which there will be a wide selection to choose from, as well as teas and coffees. We will also have a BBQ, selling hot dogs and burgers. Suffice to say, you won't go hungry!

Race Safety: The route outside the school grounds is mainly on trails with some short sections on local lanes. The course will be clearly marked with arrows and tape, as well as plenty of marshals to ensure you don't take a wrong turn.

There are three drink stations on the course. We will be using recyclable cups. Please do not leave any litter on the course.

Please respect others on the course, remember you don't have priority in public areas. The section around Stover park will be busy, especially if it's a nice day.

Race cut off: If you fail to make the 5-mile cut off point in 65 minutes you will be asked to withdraw from the race. A lift back to the finish will be provided.
